"A ghastly series of car bombings devastated government buildings across Baghdad on Tuesday this week. The terrorist attacks came as Iraqi politicians agreed at last to set a date in March for a national election. Unpopular outsiders direct terrorists and fanatics in Iraq." Said Jabbar Hasan of Iraqi Association in Hammersmith, London.

Fawzi Romani, a British citizen is one of the victims of Tuesday's nihilist attack. Romani was 79, and he was an active volunteer of our Association's elderly day-centre in Grove Neighbourhood Centre, Hammersmith. He was from the west London area. We will all sadly miss Romani. The blast killed more than 80 and wounding 400 people. The sadistic campaign of evil terrorists and fanatics must be condemned by all civilized people.

"The explosion, aimed to kill so many, this is simply an evil act." Said Hasan.

We utterly condemn Tuesday's indiscriminate acts of terror, and we wish to convey our heartfelt sympathies to families of the victims and those who were injured.
